Ad meliora 2 aimed to bring students, academicians and intellectuals from the field of law and non-law together on the digital platform to deliberate on Peace, Ethics, and Development, a theme relevant during the most challenging time of pandemic and disquiet around the globe.

The virtual conference was conducted in 4 sessions. The first session was on 23rd April from 12.00pm to 2.00pm. It started with the inauguration ceremony. 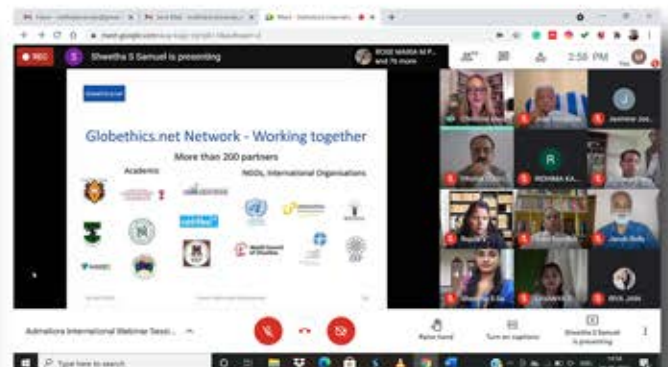
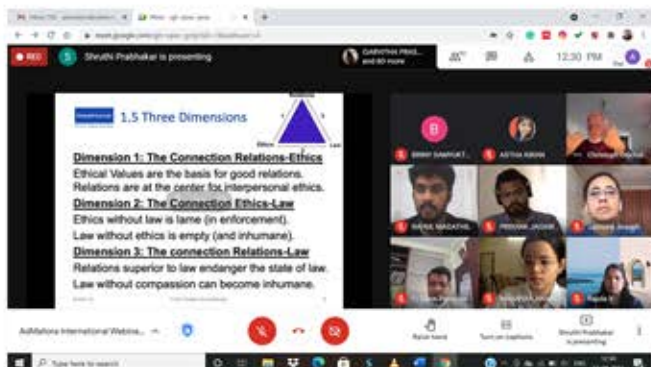
