ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

The conflicts, insecurity, weak institutions and limited access to justice adversely affect the sustainable development goals. Equal access to justice, as being the fundamental principle of the rule of Law of any country, deprived and distorted around the globe for millions of people including women, children, elderly, refugees, prisoners, differently abled and many other categories of global population. the disputes related to natural resources would bring stabilization and resilience in these conflict-affected areas.

The world Inequality report of 2018 published by the United Nations mentioned that the income inequality is largely caused by the inequalities in education. According to this report, global income inequality raised the burden of global poverty. Developmental gains of MDG needs the feature of empowerment to reach the marginalized and vulnerable.
