
**Sub: Important Instructions**

Please note the following important instructions regarding the changes in the academic calendar:

- The final attendance of the Odd Semester of the AY 2025-26, will be calculated from **14.08.2025** for the KSLU examinations.
- **70% attendance** is mandatory by the end of the semester to be eligible to appear for the End Semester KSLU Examinations.
- A minimum of **70% attendance** is mandatory at the time of registering for the University Examinations. Registration is compulsory for all students to be eligible to write the KSLU examinations. Students who have **NOT attained the minimum 70% attendance at the time of registration will NOT be registered**, and even if the required attendance is achieved later, they will still remain ineligible to appear for the examinations as per KSLU guidelines.
- The dates of the mid-term examinations will be **rescheduled** in line with the University's updated calendar schedule. Mid-term exams are usually scheduled after completion of 10 weeks (tentatively in the **last week of October 2025**). Revised dates will be announced once confirmed by the University.
- Dates for the Pre-Final examination will be announced in the revised academic calendar.
- **5 Library hours** will be granted for library attendance as below:  
14<sup>th</sup> Aug to 30<sup>th</sup> Aug - library attendance attained 80% and above – 1 attendance  
1<sup>st</sup> Sept to 30<sup>th</sup> Sept – library attendance attained 80% and above - 3 attendance  
8<sup>th</sup> Oct to 15<sup>th</sup> Nov – library attendance attained 80% and above - 1 attendance  
*Note: Library hours are part of the timetable and closely monitored by the faculty and Library Committee.*
- **No extra hours / attendance** will be calculated for the attendance of Add-on, Court visit and Mentorship.
- The class timings from **17<sup>th</sup> Nov to 11<sup>th</sup> Dec**, which is mentioned in the academic calendar as **7:30 AM to 11:00 AM** for pursuing internships will **NOT be followed**. The classes will be conducted as regular, till 1.30 pm. Students are advised to do their internship during the months of December (after the last instruction day) / January taking the examination dates into consideration. The IX semester students will also follow the timings as per timetable on these dates. They are encouraged to take up internship post regular class hours.
- As per the University notification, 14<sup>th</sup> August 2025 will be considered the class commencement date. This may result in **changes to the last instruction day** of the semester. Any such changes will be announced after receiving the updated University calendar.
